# Parsifal<sup>TM</sup>

## Monitor Packing Instructions

The packing accessories are:

- i. (1) ATA approved flight case;
- ii. (1) Accessory box;
- iii. (2) 13-1/2" x 8-1/2" protective foams;
- iv. (1) Package containing the owner's manual.

The monitor flight case has a hinged cover with two locking latches and provides space for:

- i. (2) Monitor cabinets;
- ii. (2) Speaker grilles;
- iii. (2) Granite isolating platforms;
- iv. (1) Owner's manual and registration card;
- v. (1) Accessory box.

The accessory plastic box contains:

- i. (4) Connector posts.

1. Remove the four connector posts from the monitor module;
2. Open the cover of the monitor flight case;
3. Insert one granite isolating platform at the bottom of the right compartment;
4. Lay the speaker grille over the right platform. The grille must be *facing upwards*. Holes are provided to accept the four grille stem fixations;
5. Cover with the protective foam;
6. Insert the remaining platform and grille in the left compartment. See steps 3, 4 and 5;
7. Tilt the flight case down on the floor having the opened cover laying flat on the floor. The case should be slightly angled;
8. Gently insert both monitors *upright* in their respective compartments having the *front* of the monitor *facing out*. *The foam used inside the packaging is none abrasive. Pre-enveloping the monitors is not required;*
9. Move the flight case back on its upright position;
10. Place the four connector posts inside the provided plastic box;
11. Attach the plastic box inside the cover. *Make sure it is firmly held in place;*
12. Attach the owner's manual inside the cover;
13. Carefully shut the cover and secure it by closing the two latches. *Locking the latches with tie wraps is highly recommended;*
14. The Parsifal Monitors are ready to be addressed and shipped.

## Monitor Unpacking Instructions

The packing accessories are:

- i. (1) ATA approved flight case;
- ii. (1) Accessory box;
- iii. (2) 13-1/2" x 8-1/2" protective foams;
- iv. (1) Package containing the owner's manual.

The monitor flight case has a hinged cover with two locking latches and provides space for:

- i. (2) Monitor cabinets;
- ii. (2) Speaker grilles;
- iii. (2) Granite isolating platforms
- iv. (1) Owner's manual and registration card;
- v. (1) Accessory box.

The accessory plastic box contains:

- i. (4) Connector posts.

1. Cut and remove the tie wraps which securely holds the two latches of the monitor's flight case;
2. Lift each of the latch's handles, then twist counterclockwise 180 degrees and pull to release;
3. Open the flight case cover;

4. **IMPORTANT.** Gently tilt the flight case down on the floor until the opened cover lays flat on the floor. The case should be slightly angled having the monitors facing up;
5. Carefully remove the monitors from their flight case;
6. Reposition the flight case on its right side up;
7. At the bottom of each division, you will find the two speaker grilles and the two isolating granite platforms;
8. The connector posts are attached inside the flight case cover;
9. The owner's manual and the warranty card are also attached inside the flight case cover;
10. For proper installation, please read the Installation Chapter of the manual;
11. After installation, you should place unused accessories inside the case before storage.
