

# Parsifal<sup>TM</sup>

## Woofers Unpacking Instructions

The packing accessories are:

- i. (1) ATA approved flight case;
- ii. (2) Fabric covers;
- iii. (2) Set of short Velcro straps;
- iv. (2) Set of long Velcro straps;
- v. (1) Accessory box;
- vi. (1) Owner's manual & documentation package.

The flight case is composed of a main box and a removable cover. It provides space for:

- i. (2) Woofer cabinets;
- ii. (2) Speaker grilles;
- iii. (1) Owner's manual and documentation;
- iv. (1) Accessory box.

The accessory box contains:

- i. (2) Verity Audio logo plates;
- ii. (2) Parsifal logo plates;
- iii. (8) Connector posts;
- iv. (4) Jumper cables (2 black, 2 white);
- v. (8) Threaded spikes;
- vi. (8) Threaded spike locking nuts.

1. Cut and remove the tie wraps which securely holds the four latches of the woofer flight case;
2. Lift each of the latch's handles, then twist counterclockwise 180 degrees and pull to release the latches;
3. Open and remove completely the upper shell of the flight case;

4. With the help of the Velcro straps, lift the woofer cabinet out of the flight case and lay it down carefully on the floor. **During this operation make sure the cabinet stays horizontal at all times. Be careful not to damage the drive unit.** Repeat this operation for the second woofer;
5. Assemble the (8) spike locking nuts with the (8) threaded spikes. Leave approximately half an inch between the tip end and the nut. Put them aside for latter installation (*once you have found the final placement of the speakers*);
6. Untie the Velcro attached on the protective fabric pocket located underneath the cabinet and screw the threaded spikes in each cone;
7. Put the woofer cabinet upright, untie the two Velcro straps and release the protective fabric bag by pulling on it;
8. Install both woofers at their respective proper listening positions with the drivers and ports facing the rear wall (rear firing);
9. Screw the connector posts halfway at the rear of each woofer module;
10. Insert the logo plates (2 pairs) inside the unused woofer cabinet front connectors;
11. For proper installation, please read the Installation Chapter of the manual;
12. After installation, you should place unused accessories inside the case before storage.

## Woofers Packing Instructions

The packing accessories are:

- i. (1) ATA approved flight case;
- ii. (2) Fabric covers;
- iii. (2) Set of short Velcro straps;
- iv. (2) Set of long Velcro straps;
- v. (1) Accessory box;
- vi. (1) Package containing the owner's manual.

The flight case has four locking latches and provides space for:

- i. (2) Woofer cabinets;
- ii. (2) Speaker grilles;
- iii. (1) Owner's manual and registration card;
- iv. (1) Accessory box.

The accessory box provides space for:

- i. (2) Verity Audio logo plates;
- ii. (2) Parsifal logo plates;
- iii. (8) Connector posts;
- iv. (4) Jumper cables (2 black, 2 white);
- v. (8) Threaded spikes;
- vi. (8) Threaded spike locking nuts.

1. Remove the connector posts and the logo plates from the woofer's module;
2. Cover the woofer with the supplied protective fabric;
3. Carefully turn the woofer upside down;
4. Remove the four threaded spikes and locking nuts;
5. Attach the fabric cover Velcro fasteners at each corner of the cabinet;
6. Take the set of *long* Velcro straps (1 male and 1 female) and join both ends together for a proximate length of seven inches. Firmly strap the cabinets at 2 inches from the edge of the *cabinet's bottom*;
7. Take the set of *short* Velcro straps (1 male and 1 female) and join both ends together for approximate length of seven inches. Firmly strap the cabinet at 2 inches from the edge of the *cabinet's top*;
8. Lay the woofer cabinet on the floor with the driver facing up;
9. Repeat step 1 to 8 for the second woofer cabinet;
10. Bring the bottom flight case next to the woofer cabinets;
11. Take the woofer cabinet by the two Velcro straps and carefully install it inside the flight case with the bottom facing the accessory box emplacement;
12. Repeat step 11 for the second woofer cabinet;
13. Store the connector posts, the threaded spikes and the locking nuts in their respective supplied plastic box;
14. Prepare the accessory box and place it inside the flight case;
15. Insert both grilles face to face inside the provided slot located next to the accessory box;
16. Attach the owner's manual inside the provided space found in the inner cover;
17. Carefully install the flight case cover by matching the two black pop rivets together;
18. Secure the cover in place by closing the four latches. *Locking the latches with tie wraps is highly recommended*;
19. The Parsifal woofers are ready to be addressed and shipped.
